IEEE SENSORS 2015 will include keynote addresses and invited presentations by eminent scientists. The Conference solicits original state-of-the-art contributions as well as review papers.

Late News Paper Submissions:

This option is for reporting recent discoveries that were not available at the earlier abstract submission deadline. Authors submit four-page papers that are accepted as-is, or rejected. These papers are fully peer-reviewed. Revisions are not possible. Accepted papers are inserted into podium and poster sessions, and are published in the Conference Proceedings and IEEE Xplore.

Industry Track Submissions:

IEEE SENSORS 2015 will feature a new full-day Industry Track on Wednesday, November 4. These submissions require a one-page abstract and are evaluated on a rapid review cycle. The submissions are not published in the Conference Proceedings or in IEEE Xplore. Instead, the accepted abstracts are distributed to conference attendees on a USB drive. Presentations of accepted abstracts may be assigned to a podium or poster session. Companies are encouraged to present the technologies behind, and innovative applications of, their products. Pure marketing presentations are not appropriate.

Open Poster Submissions:

This option is for authors who want to explore new ideas and concepts with colleagues in the profession. Inventors can use this option to publicize their intellectual property that is available for licensing. Candidate posters (size limit is 100 cm. width x 140 cm. height) are submitted and are evaluated in a rapid review cycle for appropriateness for the technical scope of the conference. The submissions are not published in the Conference Proceedings or in IEEE Xplore. Instead, they are distributed to conference attendees on a USB drive. Companies that only want to present applications and supporting technologies for their products in a poster environment are welcomed to select this option.
